The Boyer family has run one of the top estates in the Costières de Nîmes appellation, Chateau Beaubois, for four generations, and they've produced a beautiful 2013 Confidence. The 2013 Costières de Nîmes Confidence is a blend of 90% Grenache and 10% Syrah; it has a ripe, rounded and decidedly Provencal feel in its garrigue, black raspberry, peppery herbs and licorice bouquet. It expands on the palate, has a wonderful texture and an endearing, supple, drink-me-now feel. It should evolve nicely for 4-5 years, but I see no need to hold off. It's absolutely worth the 21 dollar entry fee.
